Fuel: Sunoco, the official racing fuel for SpeedTour events, will be available at the fuel pumps. Blends include:

93, 95, 100, 110, 112. Please note that all handheld fuel jugs must be RED, no exceptions. There will be a

fuel attendant at the pumps to assist you with fueling.

Fueling Hours: Pumps open one hour before hot track and close one hour before cold track.

Track Walk: Track walks will be available Wednesday 5-7pm, Thursday and Friday evenings after track activity has

completed. Listen to the PA for additional information. No motorized vehicles. Please be cautious of

vehicles doing track maintenance.

Lightning Policy: NJMP will stop all activities when lightning is within 10 miles of the facility.

NJMP will receive early communications when lightning is within 25, 15 and 10 miles of NJMP.

When lightning reaches 10 miles the Alert Horn System:

■ -One Long 15-Second Horn Blast = Lightning Detected & Seek Shelter Immediately.

-Strobe Flashing = Lightning is in area and under alert - Stay in shelter.

-Three Short 5-Second Horn Blasts = ALL CLEAR and safe to resume outdoor activities.


