The Stewards, having received a protest from Champagne Racing on behalf of driver Gastón Irazú (Ligier JFC #42) (Document No JFC-P1-VIR), having examined video evidence, summoned and heard from driver Gastón Irazú and team representative Victor Rubin (Champagne Racing) and driver Alex Berg (Ligier JFC #98) and team representative Allen Berg (Berg Racing), have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No/Driver 98 – Alex Berg

Competitor Berg Racing

Time 10:19

Session Race 1 (Round 12 of the Championship)

Facts Champagne Racing filed a protest against Ligier JFC #98 alleging that the driver forced #42 off

the racing surface at turn 14. The Stewards reviewed the protest, found it timely and admissible, and summoned the drivers and team representatives for a hearing at 14:30. The drivers and team

representatives named above represented the respective teams at the hearing.

Offence Alleged breach of Article 15.1(e) of the Sporting Regulations.

Decision No further action.

Reason The Stewards determined that car 42 left the surface at turn 14 as a result of close racing with car

98 and the choice of track positioning by car 42. The Stewards disallow the protest but, given the

circumstances, direct the protest deposit to be returned to the protestor.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards in accordance with Article 16.2 of the Sporting Regulations, except where the penalties are <u>not</u> susceptible to appeal (Articles 16.1.4.d, 16.2.2.e and 16.2.5 of the Sporting Regulations), within the applicable time limits.
