Welcome to the FR Americas, F4 US Championship, and the Ligier Junior Formula Championship for the 2026 season! We are excited that you are going to join our series and we want to make things as straightforward as possible for you. Thanks for being patient while our Registration Process has undergone a significant makeover in the offseason. Even if you've been racing with one of these series for several years, **please read and follow** the below checklist. It will help you get off the grid with a minimal hassle.

The Formula Series are all moving to MotorsportReg, so most everything will have a different look and feel. While I will do everything I can do to help you, this system change comes with four goals in mind: 1) Enable you to do as much as you possibly can on your own with a more mobile-friendly platform, and 2) maximize the value of the systems we have in place, 3) [hopefully] reduce the amount of time I spend between events working on the multitude of details (aka "herding cats"), and 4) allow you to securely store your credit card number within your MotorsportReg account.

Click on the link above in bold to go to the Vehicle Registration form on MotorsportReg.

Click on the "Register Now" button. Sign into your MotorsportReg account. If you don't already have an account, please follow the steps "Sign up for MotorsportReg".

*If you are a team manager, it is important to note that you will need to register ***ALL*** of your vehicles at this time.*

- Please select the class for your vehicle and follow the form to complete the information. It is important to let us know which events you might attend, as not everyone runs the entire season.
- Please read the Event Terms, then click the check box.
- Read the Terms and Conditions and click that checkbox.
- Then Click to Proceed to Checkout.
- In the "Confirm and Pay" window, you can choose to select to pay by credit card or ACH payment by adding your information. Your registration will be placed on-hold until the number confirmation process happens. (Racing America has sole discretion on assigning numbers. Prior year numbers are set aside for the teams that used them in 2025 until March 1, 2026 unless assigned by Racing America for commercial purposes. Completed vehicle registrations must be submitted by that date to retain the same number as the year before. After that time, numbers will be available on a first-come first-served basis.)
- Once your car number is confirmed – your payment will be processed using your selected payment.

Annual Credentials:

If the team is paying for credentials, then the team manager must submit all application forms. You can only register for one event with one email address. As a team manager, you can create "child" profiles inside of your account for your team members. This process will allow you to pay for all of the credentials and memberships together.

Click on the link above in bold to go to the Annual Credential Application on MotorsportReg.

Click on the "Register Now" button. Sign into your MotorsportReg account. If you don't already have an account, please follow the steps "Sign up for MotorsportReg".

All Annual Credential holders will need to complete ***both*** the Racing America SpeedWaiver and the SCCA Annual Waiver.

Once your SCCA membership and waivers are confirmed – the payment will be processed.

SCCA Annual Waiver Steps

- On the Main Screen, go to the Online Store heading. Select "Licenses & Waivers" from the dropdown list.
- Select correct Annual Waiver and click "Add to Cart".
- Click the Dropbox "Get Started" button.
- Review the Release and Waiver of Liability, then check the box at the bottom of the page.
- Click "Continue".
- Upload a photo of yourself (in a PNG, GIF, or TIFF format) and Click "Next".
- Read the Terms of Service and Click "I Agree".
- Click "Check-Out", follow the prompts to click on "Complete Order" to finish the process. Amount due should be \$0.00.
- Upon receiving the "SCCA Waiver/License Approved" email, please forward it to formularegistration@racingamerica.com.

If documents are not uploaded within the application process, they can be emailed to formularegistration@racingamerica.com. The above documents (based on your path) must be completed and submitted to proceed with the licensing process.

Note: If you are licensed with and racing for a team which collects the prize money on your behalf, please send an email to formularegistration@racingamerica.com stating that the team will collect all prize money. Then ask your team manager to complete these documents and return them to formularegistration@racingamerica.com.

All drivers (regardless of licensing path) will need to complete the following steps in the web form:

- Select your championship.
- All drivers licensed with the Series are required to be SCCA members throughout the duration of the FIA season. If you are not yet an SCCA member, please select “New Member”.
If you are an SCCA member and your membership expires prior to November 2026, you **must** select “Renew”.
- A “head shot” photo must be submitted. *Fair Warning:* If you fail to submit a headshot photo, the photo taken during the Digital Waiver process will appear on your license/credential.
- You will enter your phone number for the Digital Waiver. Once you receive the text message, please complete the Digital Waiver promptly.

- Please read the Event Terms, then click the check box.
- Read the Terms and Conditions and click that checkbox.
- Then Click to Proceed to Checkout.
- In the “Confirm and Pay” window, you can choose to select to pay by credit card or ACH payment by adding your information. Your registration will be placed on-hold until your license is approved.
- You will also need to complete the SCCA Annual Waiver by logging into your SCCA account at my.scca.com and following the steps (outlined in the Annual Credential portion above) to the Online Store and purchasing an Annual Waiver (cost is \$0.00).
- Once your license and SCCA membership is confirmed – your payment will be processed using your selected payment method.
