The Stewards, having received a report from the Technical Delegate (Document No JFC-2026-02) and heard from driver Beckham Jacir and team representative Victor Rubin, have considered the following matter and determine the following:

No/Driver	7 – Beckham Jacir
Competitor	Champagne Racing
Time	15:00
Session	Qualifying (Round 4 of the Championship)
Facts	The technical delegate found that the downloaded data shows a single long lap in the series mandated data system. This occurred because the beacon receiver was not securely mounted, and this prevented the series from providing the fastest lap data of car #7.
Offence	Alleged breach of Articles 23.13 of the Sporting Regulations.
Decision	The team has been directed to correct the beacon receiver mounting prior to the next on-track session. Beyond this, the stewards take no further action.
Reason	The stewards found that there were extenuating circumstances regarding the mounting of the beacon receiver on car #7. The stewards ask that the technical director clarify the regulations regarding beacon receiver mounting requirements in a technical bulletin.

Competitors are reminded that they have the right to appeal certain decisions of the Stewards in accordance with Article 16.2 of the Sporting Regulations, except where the penalties are not susceptible to appeal (Articles 16.1.4.d, 16.2.2.e and 16.2.5 of the Sporting Regulations), within the applicable time limits.
