



## Ligier JFC Technical Advisory Memo

**Subject:** Ligier JFC cars may use the 91-octane fuel from the pumps at Road America

Attention Ligier JFC Teams,

Road America has replaced the 93-octane fuel that used to be dispensed from the pumps with 91-octane fuel. That is why the Supplemental Regulations for the Road America event specified that the 93-octane fuel had to be pre-ordered.

After consulting with Mountune, it has been approved for the F416 cars competing in JFC to use the 91-octane fuel dispensed from the Road America fuel pumps. Therefore, any JFC teams that want to cancel their pre-orders today may do so and use the 91-octane fuel at Road America. We have verified with Road America that they have sufficient fuel in the tanks to supply all the 91-octane fuel needed.

At this time, the use of the 91-octane fuel is approved only for the Road America event.

For teams that run the F422 car, Ligier has not approved the use of 91-octane fuel for the Storm engine, and therefore, those cars must pre-order and use the 93-octane fuel whether running in JFC or F4.
